BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on June 28 and August 7, 1973, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this <u>20th</u> day of February, 1985, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:

(1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) The applicant, Belco Petroleum Corporation, seeks authority to drill its proposed Felmont Federal Well No. 1 at a location 660 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the East line of Section 25, Township 20 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Potash-Oil Area, Lea County, New Mexico.

(3) This matter was scheduled for hearing on June 28, 1973, was continued to a hearing on August 7, 1973, and was thereafter continued indefinitely.

(4) An excessive amount of time having elapsed with no subsequent request for setting a hearing date, this matter should be dismissed.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

Receipt is acknowledged of your letter of March 30th in which you advise that the log on the Belco well has at last been mailed to Kerr-McGee. I enclose herewith a copy of a letter from Mr. Haag of Kerr-McGee to Belco dated April 2, 1973 in which he points out that Belco sent Kerr-McGee only the induction-electric log, not the Gamma Ray-Acoustic Velocity, Contact-Caliper and Forxo surveys which were also run on the well. You have on a number of occasions during the past several weeks been advised by your client that the logs on the well had been sent to Kerr-McGee when in fact they had not, and now when at last we did receive a log it was incomplete. I dislike having such a hassle over such a simple Would you kindly have your client forward us the matter. missing surveys immediately at our expense. If for any reason Belco is not willing to do this, would you please at least have Belco forward the porosity log since it is impossible to make any determination of porosity and/or possible pay without having that log.





Permitting the well to be drilled would constitute waste, in that production of gas would have the effect of reducing the total quantity of commercial deposits of potash that may be reasonably recovered in commercial quantities, would unduly interfere with the orderly development of the potash deposits and would create hazards to mining.
