In the matter of the application of the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico upon its own motion for an order for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, and the extension of certain existing pools in Chaves, Lea, and Roosevelt Counties, New Mexico, and giving notice to all persons and parties interested in the subject matter thereof to appear and show cause why such creations and extensions should not be made.

a) Create a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Seven Rivers production and designated as the Leasco Seven Rivers Pool. Further to assign approximately 18,920 barrels of oil discovery allowance to the discovery well, the ~~South Vierson~~ Vierson & Cochran Leasing Well No. 4 located in Unit D of Section 30, Township 18 South, Range 39 East, NMPM. Said well was completed September 9, 1974. The top of the perforations is at 3784 feet. Said pool would comprise Township 18 South Range 39 East, NMPM Section 30: SE 1/4

b) CREATE A new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as a gas pool for McKee production and designated as the Crosby-McKee Gas Pool. The discovery well is Union Texas Petroleum Corporation, Crosby Deep Well No. 3 located in Unit J of Section 33, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, NMPM. Said pool described as:
