

The Calumet Ranch Unit agreement, Chaves County, New Mexico, was approved March 14, 1978, effective as of the same date.

Our records show that a 3-month extension of time was approved up to March 4, 1980, in which to commence the second test well. In-asmuch as such well was not commenced, the Calumet Ranch Unit agreement has terminated automatically by the terms of the agreement as of March 4, 1980.

Gentlemen:

The Calumet Ranch unit agreement, Chaves County, New Mexico, was approved March 14, 1978 by the Acting Area Oil and Gas Supervisor, effective the date approved. The term of such agreement is contingent upon the unit operator drilling one well at a time, allowing not more than six months' time between the completion of one well and the beginning of the next well, until a well capable of producing unitized substances in paying quantities is completed.

Unit well No. I was completed in the Strawn formation in December, 1978. A six-month extension to make a commercial determination or start the second well was approved, and a subsequent three-month extension was granted. The second test well or the commercial determination on the No. I well was due by midnight on March 4, 1980. Inasmuch as well No. 2 was not commenced and the commercial determination was not made on well No. I, the Calumet Ranch unit agreement is considered to have terminated automatically as of March 4, 1980.

Your amplication of February 1, 1978, filed in behalf of Boad & Stevens, Inc., with the Assistant Area Dil and Gas Supervisor, Roswell, New Mexico, requests the designation of the Calumet Ranch unit, embracing 6,700.00 acres, more or less, in Chaves County, New Mexico, as legically subject to exploration and development under the unitization provisions of the Mineral Leasing Act, as Amended.

Pursuant to unit plan regulations 30 CFR 220, the land requested as outlined on your plat marked "Exchibit 'A', Calumet Ranch Unit Area' is bord'y designated as a logical unit area.

The mail agreement submitted for the area designated should provide for a well to test all formations of Pennsylvanian age or to a depth of 0,700 feet. Your proposed use of the Form of Agreement for Unproved Areas, malified as shown in your application, will be accepted, provided it is European modified to include appropriate language for fee lands.

If conditions are such that further modification of said standard form is locked accessary, two copies of the proposed modifications with appropriate justification must be submitted to this office through the Oil ordinar Supervisor for preliminary approval.

In the absence of any other type of land requiring special provisions or of any objections not now apparent, a duly executed agreement identical with said form, modified as outlined above, will be approved if submitted in approvable status within a reasonable period of time. However, notice is bereby given that the right is reserved to deny approval of any executed agreement submitted which is our opinion, does not have the full consitment of sufficient lands to afford effective control of operations in the unit area.

When the executed agreement is transmitted to Roswell, New Mexico for the Supervisor's approval, include the latest status of all acreage. In preparation of Exhibits "A" and "B", follow closely the format of the sample exhibits attached to the 1968 reprint of the aforementioned form.

Inasmuch as this agreement involves State lands, we are sending a copy of the letter to the Commissioner of Public Lands. Please contact the State of New Mexico before soliciting joinders regardless of prior contacts or clearance from the State.
