On November 20, 1980, Mr. Gholson and I made an inspection of the above well and lease. We found the operations in violation of several provisions of Order R-6220:

- There was no gauge or leak detection device installed on the well annulus. The two valves on the annulus were frozen shut and could not be opened.
- 2. The injection system was operating at approximately 1500 psi in violation of the 1155 psi limitation.

Other problems we found on inspection were as follows:

- 1. Lack of warning signs about poisonous gas.
- 2. An oil spill at the #3 well which will require notification as per Rule 116.

You are hereby directed to take immediate action to correct the violations. Please make arrangements with this office to inspect the well and lease after the violations are corrected.
