And have you, in the course of this thorough review you've made of these exhibits, assured yourself of 10 11 their accuracy? 12 You bet. Α. MR. STOVALL: I move the admission of Exhibits 1 in 13 14 each case and have nothing further. 15 EXAMINER STOGNER: Both Exhibits 1 will be admitted 16 into evidence at this time, and this witness may be 17 excused. (Whereupon Exhibits 1 were admitted into evidence.) 18 19 Anything further in either Case 10277 or 10278 20 at this time? 21 Then, these two cases will be under advisement, 22 and the hearing is adjourned. 23 (The foregoing hearing was concluded at the 24 approximate hour of 3:45 p.m.) 25
