BY THE DIVISION:

It appearing to the Division that Order No. R-9544 dated July 1, 1991, does not correctly state the intended order of the Division,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

- (1) Finding Paragraph No. 5 on page 2 of said Division Order No. R-9544 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - "(5) There is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Blinebry formation, said pool to bear the designation of South House-Blinebry Pool. Said South House-Blinebry Pool was discovered by the Seay Exploration Inc. House Well No. 1 located in Unit D of Section 13, Township 20 South, Range 38 East, NMPM. It was completed in the Blinebry formation on February 28, 1991. The top of the perforations is at 6,008 feet."
- (2) Decretory Paragraph (d) on page 4 of said Order No. R-9544 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - "(d) A new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Blinebry production is hereby created and designated as the South House-Blinebry Pool, consisting of the following described area:

TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, NMPM Section 13: NW/4"
