- CASE 10340: Application of Meridian Oil Inc. for a high angle/horizontal directional drilling pilot project, special operating rules therefor, a non-standard oil proration unit, an unorthodox gas well location, and an exception to Division Order No. R-5459, as amended. San Juan County, New Mexico. Applicant, in the above-styled cause, seeks to initiate a high angle/horizontal directional drilling pilot project in the Chacra formation underlying the E/2 of Section 34, Township 30 North, Range 8 West, forming a 320-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit for the producing interval. The applicant purposes to drill from a tentative unorthodox surface well location 2040 feet from the North line and 2030 feet from the East line (Unit G) of said Section 34, kick-off from vertical in a southeasterly direction until an angle of approximately 90 degrees is achieved and continue drilling horizontally for approximately 1600 feet. Applicant further seeks the adoption of special operating provisions and rules within the pilot project area including the designation of a prescribed area limiting the horizontal displacement of said well's producing interval such that it can be no closer than 790 feet to the outer boundary of the aforementioned 320-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit. Also the applicant seeks an exception to the provisions of Division Order No. R-5459, as amended, to exclude the E/2 of said Section 34 from the vertical limits of the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool as defined by said Order. Said unit is located approximately 3.5 miles southwest of the Navajo Reservoir Dam.
- **CASE 19941:** Application of Marathon Oil Company for statutory unitization, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant, in the above-styled cause, seeks an order unitizing, for the purpose of authorizing a pressure maintenance project, all mineral interests in the Tamano-Bone Spring Pool underlying 880 acres, more or less, of Federal lands comprising the S/2 NE/4 and SE/4 of Section 10 and all of Section 11, Township 18 South, Range 31 East. Said Unit is to be designated the Tamano (BSSC) Unit. Among the matters to be considered at the hearing will be the necessity of unit operations; the designation of a unit operator; the determination of horizontal and vertical limits of the unit area; the determination of the fair, reasonable, and equitable allocation of production and costs of production, including capital investment, to each of the various tracts in the unit area; the determination of credits and charges to be made among the various owners in the unit area for their investment in wells and equipment; and such other matters as may be necessary and appropriate for carrying on efficient unit operations; including but not limited to, unit voting procedures, selection, removal or substitution of unit operator, and time of commencement and termination of unit operations. Said Unit Area is located approximately 8.5 miles east-southeast of Loco Hills, New Mexico.
- <u>CASE 10342</u>: Application of Marathon Oil Company for pressure maintenance project, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant, in the abovestyled cause, seeks authority to institute a pressure maintenance project in its proposed Tamano (BSSC) Unit Area comprising the S/2 NE/4 and SE/4 of Section 10 and all of Section 11, Township 18 South, Range 31 East, by the injection of water into the Tamano-Bone Spring Pool at a surface limitation pressure in excess of the Division's 0.2 psi guidelines but not in excess of 2300 psi surface pressure through the perforated interval from approximately 7950 feet to 8230 feet in 5 wells to be converted from producing oil wells to injection wells. Said project area is located approximately 8.5 miles east-southeast of Loco Hills, New Mexico.

## STATEMENT OF CASE

#### APPLICANT
