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STATEMENT OF CASE

APPLICANT

Bird Creek Resources, Inc. seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Delaware formation or to a depth of 6300 feet, whichever is deeper, underlying the SE/4NE/4 (Unit H) of Section 22, T23S, R28E, forming a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit for any and all formations and/or pools developed on 40-acre oil spacing within said vertical extent, which presently includes but is not necessarily limited to the East Loving-Delaware Pool. Said unit is to be dedicated to a well to be drilled at a standard oil well location thereon. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well and a charge for risk involved in drilling said well.

Bird Creek has sought the voluntary agreement of the owners of the non-consenting working interests and has been unable to obtain voluntary agreement.
