As you are aware, Order No. R-9636, entered on February 12, 1992 in the above-referenced case, did not clarify the status of production which occurred from the subject proration units after March 30, 1991 and prior to the filing of deliverability tests in March and June, 1991 for the wells located thereon.

It is Great Lakes' understanding of this Order that the Division intends to cancel all overproduction from the wells on each of these units prior to the filing of the 1991 deliverability tests. Accordingly, we request that Order No. R-9636 be clarified with a <u>nunc pro tunc</u> Order amending Finding (26) to read as follows:

(26) "Considering the mitigating circumstances of this case, all of the applicable rules governing the proration of gas in the Blanco Mesaverde Pool should be observed. Therefore, the four gas proration units that are subject in this case should be assigned allowables equal to zero for the period of April 1, 1987 to March 30, 1991 or the effective date of allowable assignment based upon deliverability tests taken and effective in 1991, whichever is later. Further, each proration unit should be made to accrue overproduction in the amounts shown in Finding Paragraph No. 25 above. HOWEVER, notwithstanding Great Lakes' inadvertence in this matter, said overproduction in each of the four gas proration units should be adjusted to zero as of 7:00 o'clock a.m. on April 1, 1991, or the effective date of allowable assignment based upon deliverability tests taken and effective in 1991, whichever is later."

Order Paragraph (4) should also be amended to provide as follows:

(4) "All overproduction in each of the four gas proration units shall be adjusted to zero as of 7:00 o'clock a.m. on April 1, 1991, or the effective date of allowable assignment based upon 1991 deliverability tests, whichever is later."

Your attention to this request is appreciated.
