NOW, on this 27th day of January, 1992, the Division Director, having considered the record and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

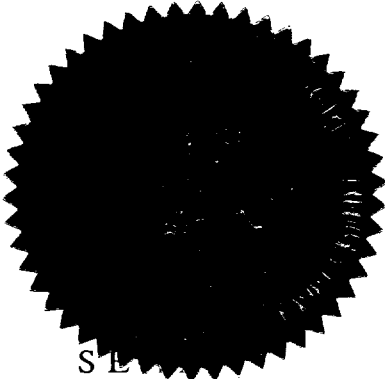
FINDS THAT:

The applicant's request for dismissal should be granted.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:
