

A P P L I C A T I O N

COMES NOW MITCHELL ENERGY CORPORATION, by and through its attorneys, KELLAHIN, KELLAHIN & AUBREY, and applies to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for approval of an unorthodox gas well location to be located 1980 feet FNL and 660 feet FWL in Section 18, T19S, R32E, NMPM for production from the Lusk-Atoka Gas Pool or the Lusk-Morrow Gas Pool with dedication of a non-standard spacing and proration unit for gas production consisting of 281.61 acres being the NE/4, lots 1 and 2 (W/2NW/4), and NE/4NW/4 of said Section 18 and for oil production consisting of 120 acres being lots 1 and 2 (W/2NW/4) and NE/4NW/4 of said Section 18, and in support states:

1. Applicant, Mitchell Energy Corporation, is the operator of and has the right to drill and develop

the NE/4, E/2NW/4, and NW/4NE/4 of Section 18, T19S, R32E, NMPM and is identified herein as Area 1 on Exhibit "A".

2. The SE/4NW/4 and the S/2 of Section 18 is part of the Lusk Deep Unit operated by Phillips Petroleum Company and is identified herein as Area 2 on Exhibit "A".

3. The interest owners in Area 2 of Section 18 have participated in the Lusk Deep Unit development of the Lusk-Morrow, Lusk-Strawn and Lusk-Atoka Pools while the interest owners in Area 1 of Section 18 have not participated.

4. On October 10, 1956, the Division issued Administrative Order No. NSP-766, approving the S/2 and the SE/4NW/4 of Section 18 as a 360-acre non-standard gas proration unit for the Lusk-Morrow Gas Pool for the Lusk Deep Unit Well 2 well located 660 feet FSL and 1980 feet FEL of said Section 18.

5. On June 16, 1975, Phillips Petroleum Company completed its Lusk Deep Unit "Com" Well No 13 at a location of 1980 feet FSL and FWL of said Section 18 and dedicated 640 acres to production from the Lusk-Morrow Gas Pool said spacing unit being all of Section 18.

6. On March 13, 1980, Phillips abandoned the Morrow production in the Lusk Deep Unit "Com" Well No 13 and recompleted the well into the Lusk-Atoka Gas Pool, amended the acreage dedication and dedicated the S/2 of said Section 18 to the well.

7. Applicant proposes to drill its Crazy Horse "18" Federal Well No 1 at a location 660 feet FWL and 1980 feet FNL of Section 18 (See Exhibit "B" attached) to test for production in the following pools:

8. Because of the various existing rules described above, applicant desires to obtain the following exceptions:

(a) Approval of its proposed location as an unorthodox gas well location for possible production in the Lusk-Atoka Gas Pool and the Lusk-Morrow Gas Pool.

(b) Approval of a possible non-standard oil proration unit for the Lusk-Strawn Oil Pool consisting of 121.61 acres being the NW/4 excluding the SE/4NW/4 which is in the Phillips Petroleum Company operated Lusk Deep Unit A.

(c) Approval of a possible non-standard gas proration and spacing unit consisting of 281.61 acres

for the Lusk-Atoka Gas Pool consisting of the N/2 of Section 18 excluding the SE/4NW/4 which is in the Phillips Petroleum Company operated Lusk Deep Unit A.

(d) Approval of a possible non-standard gas proration unit consisting of 281.61 acres for the Lusk-Morrow Gas Pool consisting of the NE/4, NE/4NW/4 and lots 1 and 2 (W/2NW/4) and thereby excluding the S/2 and the SE/4NW/4 which is in the Phillips Petroleum Company operated Lusk Deep Unit A.

9. Applicant has contacted Phillips Petroleum Company concerning this request and has obtained a waiver from Phillips Petroleum Company as set forth on Exhibit "C".

10. The requested unorthodox gas well location is sought to satisfy geologic considerations in developing this spacing unit.

11. In accordance with Division Rule 1207, the following notices have been sent certified mail return receipt:

(a) to all offsetting operators and in the absence of an operator, the known working interest owners towards which the subject well encroaches, as listed on Exhibit "D" attached hereto.

(b) to all offsetting operators and in the absence of an operator, the known working interest owners for the spacing units surrounding the subject non-standard proration unit, as listed on Exhibit "E" attached hereto.

(c) to the interest owners in Section 18 who may be affected by the approval of this application, as listed on Exhibit "F" attached hereto.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this application be set on the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division Examiner's docket now scheduled for July 23, 1992, and after notice and hearing the application be granted, and for such other and further relief as may be appropriate.

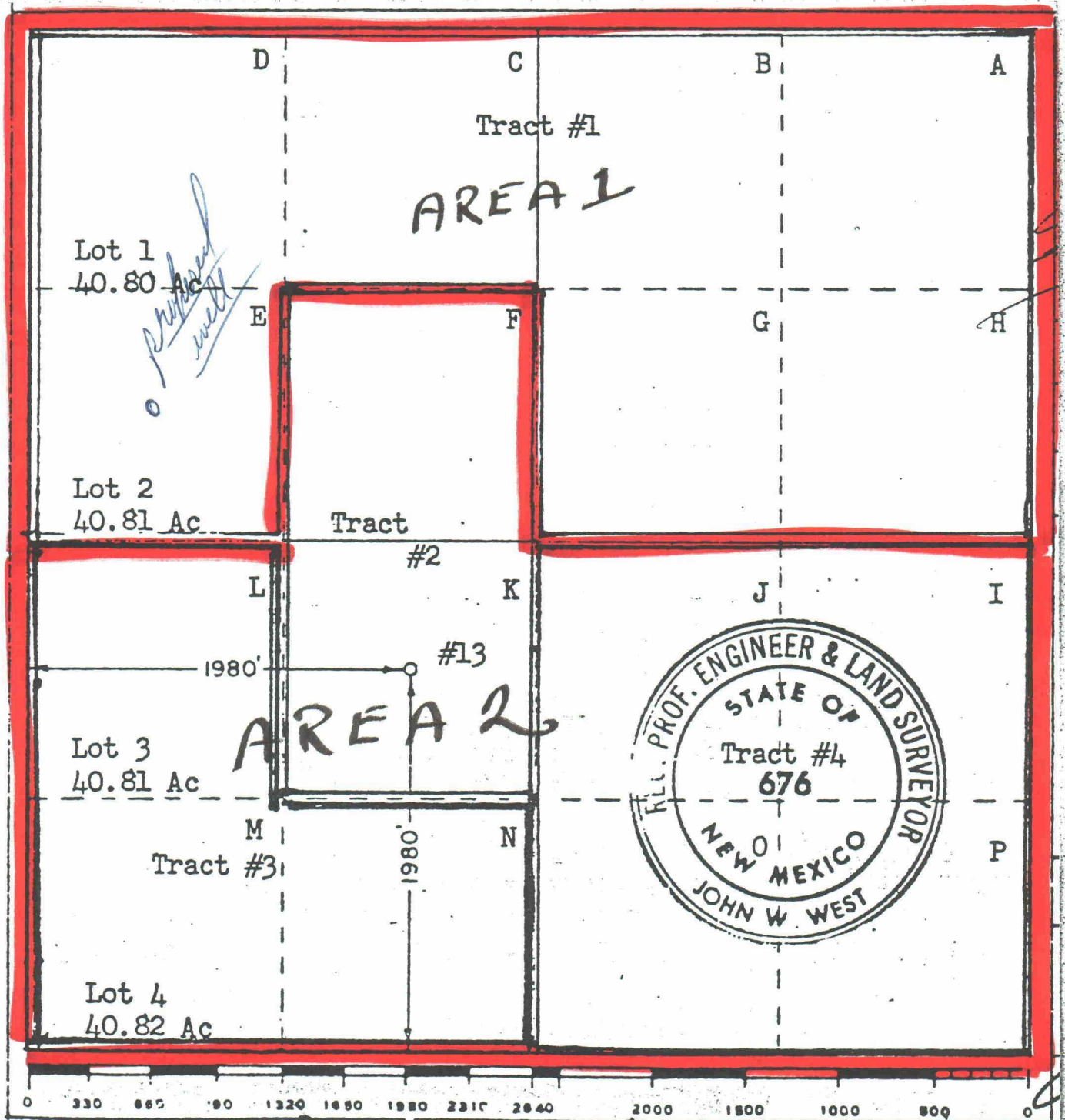


