Ladies and Gentlemen:

Phillips Petroleum Company has requested the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division to place Phillips Petroleum Company on the July 23, 1992 docket to request approval of the following unorthodox locations.

South Four Lakes Well No. 10 is to be located within a fifty foot radius of 2200' from the south line and 1980' from the east line of Section 2, T-12-S, R-34-E, with an 80 acre proration unit consisting of the N/2 SE/4 of the Section.

South Four Lakes Well No. 11 is to be located within a fifty foot radius of 1250' from the south line and 2450' from the west line of Section 35, T-12-S, R-34-E, with an 80 acre proration unit consisting of the E/2 SW/4 of the Section.

South Four Lakes Well No. 12 is to be located within a fifty foot radius of 2200' from the north line and 2150' from the west line of Section 2, T-12-S, R-34-E, with an 80 acre proration unit consisting of the E/2 NW/4 of the Section.

All three wells are located in Lea County, New Mexico.

APPLICANT

Applicant, in the above-styled case, seeks exception to RULE 4 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Four Lakes-Pennsylvanian Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-2326, for three unorthodox oil well locations each to be drilled within a fifty foot radius of the following described sites all within its South four Lakes Unit which is located approximately 10 miles west-northwest of Tatum, New Mexico.

- 220C' FSL & 1980' FEL (Unit J) of Section 2, Township 12 South, Range 34 East, the 80 acres comprising the N/2 SE/4 is to be dedicated to said well;

- 1250' FSL & 2450' FWL (Unit N) of Section 35, Township 11 South, Range 34 East, the 80 cres comprising the E/2 SW/4 is to be dedicated to said well; and,

- 2200' FNL & 2150' FWL (Unit F) of Section 2, Township 12 South, Range 34 East, the 80.11 acres comprising Lot 2 and the SE/4 NW/4 is to dedicated to said well.
