

The purpose of this letter is to respond to certain questions raised at yesterday's Examiner hearing in the above-referenced case concerning the notice letter that was mailed to Meridian Oil Inc. at 21 Desta Drive, Midland, TX 79705. The address that was utilized by Yates Petroleum Corporation in providing this notice was derived from the 1993 R. W. Byram & Company Oil & Gas Directory of New Mexico. Enclosed for the Division's information is a copy of the cover and appropriate page from this publication. By copy of this letter I am advising both Meridian and Byram of the apparent error in this address so that it can be corrected for the 1994 directory.

Yates Petroleum Corporation advises me that Meridian is not an operator of any well offsetting the tract which is the subject of Case No. 10543. Accordingly, Yates was not required to provide Meridian with notice of this application to comply with Oil Conservation Division Rule 1207. However, notice was provided because Meridian does own rights below the Morrow formation in the N/2 of Section 1, Township 19 South, Range 24 East which offsets to the East the subject spacing unit.


