

SOUTH JUSTIS UNIT Historical Events

1984

Operators in Justis Field formed Engineering Technical Committee to evaluate waterflooding the Blinebry and Tubb/Drinkard.

1986

Technical Committee hired T. Scott Hickman & Associates to conduct feasibility study of secondary operations in the Blinebry and Tubb/Drinkard.

1987

Hickman published feasibility study and recommended waterflooding field with two units. S. J. Mazullo published geological study as part of Hickman feasibility report.

1988

ARCO agreed to expedite formation of South Justis Unit.

1990

ARCO released draft of Technical Report to Technical Committee.

1991

Technical Committee recommended revised Technical Report to the working interest owners. Owners adopted the report and agreed upon equity formula for participation in the unit.

1992

ARCO obtained preliminary approval from the Bureau of Land Management and from the State Land Office of Unit Agreement and Unit Operating Agreement. A request to approve funds to implement waterflood project was sent to working interest owners.
