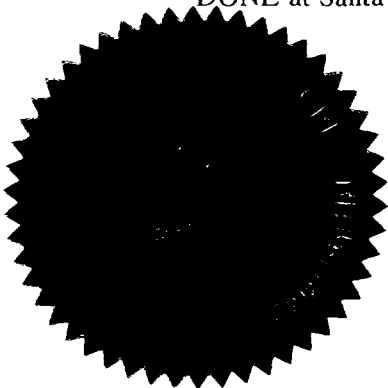
FINDS THAT:

- (4) The applicant's request for dismissal should be granted.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:
