

APPLICATION

YATES PETROLEUM CORPORATION, through its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application pursuant to the provisions of N.M.Stat.Ann. § 70-2-17, (1978), for an order pooling all mineral interests in Section 27, Township 21 South, Range 24 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico in all formations developed on 640-acre spacing (Indian Basin-Upper Pennsylvanian Gas Pool) and in all formations developed on 320-acre spacing in the S/2 of Section 27 to be dedicated to a well at an unorthodox gas well location and in support of its application, states:

1. Applicant is an owner of working interest in and under Section 27, Township 21 South, Range 24 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico and applicant has the right to drill thereon.
2. Applicant proposes to reenter an existing wellbore located at an unorthodox location 1140 feet from the South line and 1350 feet from the West line of Section 27 and drill to a depth of approximately 10,350 feet to test any and all formations from the surface to the base of the Morrow formation, Undesignated Morrow Gas Pool.
3. Applicant has sought and been unable to obtain either voluntary agreement

for pooling or farmout from Santa Fe Energy Operating Partners, L.P., the owner of the remaining working interest in Section 27.


4. Said pooling of interests and approval of an unorthodox well location will avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, will prevent waste and will protect correlative rights.

5. In order to permit the Applicant to obtain its just and fair share of the oil and gas underlying the subject lands, the mineral interests should be pooled, the proposed unorthodox location approved, and Applicant should be designated the operator of the well.

WHEREFORE, Applicant prays that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on December 3, 1992 and, after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter its order approving the proposed unorthodox location, pooling the lands, including provisions for Applicant to recover its costs of drilling, equipping and completing the well, its costs of supervision while drilling and after completion, including overhead charges, and imposing a risk factor for the risk assumed by the Applicant in drilling, completing and equipping the well.
