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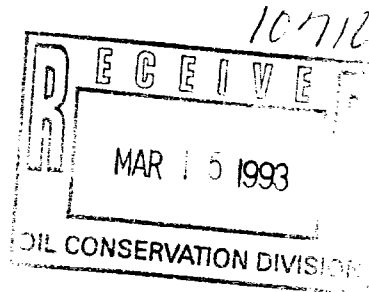

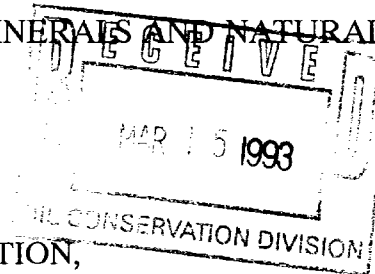

2. Applicant seeks an exception to the Division's well location requirements to permit the recompleting of the well in the Morrow formation at the above-described location.


3. A standard 320-acre proration unit comprised of the E/2 of said Section 26 should be dedicated to the well.
