### ORDER OF THE DIVISION

## BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on April 22, 1993, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Michael E. Stogner.

NOW, on this \_\_\_\_\_ day of May, 1993, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

## FINDS THAT:

- (1) Due public notice having been give as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) The applicant, S & J Operating Company, seeks approval of an unorthodox oil well location 566 feet from the South line and 15 feet from the West line (Unit M) of Section 29, Township 11 South, Range 28 East, N.M.P.M., Chaves County, New Mexico, to test the Fusselman formation.

- (3) The Fusselman formation is subject to Division Rules and Regulations requiring 40 acre spacing with wells to be not closer than 330 feet to the outer boundary of the well unit.
- (4) The applicant's primary zone of interest for this well is the Fusselman formation, and the  $SW_4^1SW_4^1$  of said Section 29 will be dedicated to the well, forming a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit.
- (5) The Fusselman formation in this area is a rollover anticline bounded to the west by a north-south trending fault.
- (6) The applicant presented three dimensional seismic data which indicates that the proposed well will penetrate the top of the Fusselman formation at its structurally highest point.
- (7) The Fred Pooling Drilling Mesquite Tank Well No. 1 was previously drilled on Unit M of said Section 29, and produced small amounts of oil. Said well has been plugged and abandoned.
- (8) The applicant presented evidence that its proposed well is structurally higher than the Mesquite Tank Well No. 1, and thus more likely to be productive of hydrocarbons.
- (9) The applicant presented evidence that ownership of working interests and royalty interests is uniform in the proposed well unit and in all offsetting quarter-quarter sections. Therefore, approval of the unorthodox well location will not adversely affect correlative rights.
- (10) No interested party objected to the proposed unorthodox gas well location.

(11) Approval of the subject application will afford the applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable share of the oil in the affected formation, will prevent the economic loss caused by the drilling of unnecessary wells, avoid the augmentation of risk arising from the drilling of an excessive number of wells, and will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

- (1) The application of S & J Operating Company for an unorthodox oil well location for the Fusselman formation is hereby approved for a well to be located 556 feet from the South line and 15 feet from the West line (Unit M) of Section 29, Township 11 South, Range 28 East, N.M.P.M., Chaves County, New Mexico.
- (2) The  $SW_4^1SW_4^1$  of said Section 29 shall be dedicated to the above-described well, forming a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit.
- (3) Jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
