- (2) The applicant, Devon Energy Corporation, seeks the promulgation of special rules for the Ingle Wells-Delaware Pool located in portions of Sections 26 and 35 of Township 23 South, Range 31 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, and in a portion of Section 2, Township 24 South, Range 31 East, including a provision for a gas/oil limitation of 5000 cubic feet of gas per barrel of oil.
 - (3) At the time of the hearing, the applicant requested this case be dismissed.
 - (4) The applicant's request for dismissal should be granted.
