#### **APPLICATION**

COMES NOW YATES PETROLEUM CORPORATION, through its undersigned attorneys, and hereby makes application for an order approving an unorthodox well location, and in support thereof states:

1. Applicant is the operator of the N/2 of Section 14, Township 21 South, Range 24 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico and proposes to drill its Yerba AMY Fed Com Well No. 1 as a gas well in all formations including the Cisco, Canyon, Strawn, Atoka and Morrow formations, at an unorthodox location 1650 feet from the North line and 1580 feet from the West line in Unit F of said Section 14.

2. Applicant seeks an exception to the Division's well location requirements to permit the drilling of said well to an approximate depth of 10,350 feet to test all formations to the base of the Morrow formation at the above-described location.

3. A standard 320-acre proration unit comprised of the N/2 of said Section 14 should be dedicated to the well.

4. Approval of this application will afford Applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable share of the gas in the Wolfcamp and Pennsylvanian formations and will otherwise be in the best interest of the conservation, the protection of correlative rights and prevention of waste.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this matter be set for hearing before a duly appointed Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on August 12, 1993, that notice be given as required by law and the rules of the Division, and that the Division enter its order granting this application and providing such other relief as is proper.
