STATEMENT OF CASE

OPPOSITION PARTY

Roderick Allen Markham and Manon Markham McMullen, as the assignees of Jack and Mary Markham, have the leasehold rights to 4.25% in the Fruitland formation underlying the SW/4 of Section 22, T30N, R12W, San Juan County, New Mexico.

The Markhams request that any pooling order entered by the Division in this case:

- (1) limit the costs to be recovered to the Markhams' proportionate share of the recompletion AFE of \$18,120.00; and
 - (2) deny any risk factor penalty.

In 1961, the subject well was completed in the Mesaverde formation and produced a cumulative total in excess of 2 BCF of gas and has not produced since March, 1987.

In May, 1993, without first attempting to notify the Markhams, Merrion Oil & Gas Company recompleted this well into the Fruitland sand formation. Then, in June, 1993, for the first time, Merrion Oil & Gas Company sent a letter to Rod Markham proposing terms for participation.

Merrion Oil & Gas Company assumed all of the risk when it undertook the recompletion work without first providing the Markhams with an AFE and the opportunity to participate in the recompletion effort.
