7 Division Order Number R-10,010, which order promulgated  
8 temporary special rules and regulatios for the Happy  
9 Valley-Delaware Pool in Eddy County, New Mexico.

10 EXAMINER CATANACH: Are there any appearances in  
11 this case?

12 MR. CARR: May it please the Examiner, my name is  
13 William F. Carr with the Santa Fe law firm Campbell, Carr,  
14 Berge and Sheridan.

15 This case was originally brought before the  
16 Commission on the application of Collins and Ware, Inc.  
17 Recently Louis Dreyfus Natural Gas Corporation has  
18 succeeded to the interests of Collins and Ware in this  
19 pool.

20 Louis Dreyfus has reviewed the available  
21 information on the wells in the pool and has concluded that  
22 the pool can effectively be developed under statewide  
23 rules.

24 Accordingly, we are not appearing here today to  
25 present additional testimony and believe it would be

1 appropriate for statewide rules to, from this time forward,  
2 govern the development of the Happy Valley-Delaware Pool.

3 EXAMINER CATANACH: Okay, are there any  
4 additional appearances or anything further in this case?

5 There being nothing further, Case 10,804 will be  
6 taken under advisement.
