All wells will be drilled such that the surface location and bottom hole location of the horizontal section will be no closer than 330' to the outer edge of the Unit boundary (see attached plat).

The leases in the field have been unitized to provide for horizontal drilling. The spacing unit for the wells, therefore, will be the entire 280 acre Unit.
