Baber Well Servicing Co. has staked and drilled the State "BZ" NCT-5 Well No. 5 as an unorthodox location at the above referenced legals.

Baber Well Servicing Co. owns 100% of the working interest in the N/2 of Section 29 and also the S/2 of Section 20. An outstanding ORRI of 1/16th in the S/2 of Section 20 keeps the ownership from being identical.

The No. 5 well was drilled to recover otherwise lost reserves, pending evaluation of the well, three other non-standard locations will be submitted for approval.

The ultimate goal is to infill drill on a 20 acre spacing an eventually waterflood the lease.

Offset operators will be notified of the hearing via certified mail. As per rule 12-10, we will make this notification at least 21 days prior to the hearing.
