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



1. Applicant is the operator of the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 2, Township 20 South, Range 34 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico and proposes to drill its Mobil Lea State Well No. 6 as an oil well in the Delaware formation, Northeast Lea-Delaware Pool, 2,590 feet from the North line and 1,980 feet from the West line in Unit F of said Section 2.
2. Applicant seeks an exception to the Division's well location requirements to permit the drilling of said well in the Delaware formation at the above-described location.
3. A standard 40-acre spacing and proration unit comprised of the SE/4 NW/4 of said Section 2 should be dedicated to the well.
4. Approval of this application will afford Applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable share of the oil and gas from the Delaware formation and will otherwise be in the best interest of the conservation, the protection of correlative rights and the prevention of waste.
