3 Mexico, as a petroleum engineer.

4 Q Mr. Stogner, have you previously testi-
5 fied before the Commission or its examiners and had your
6 credentials accepted?

7 A Yes, I have.

8 Q Are you prepared to make recommendations
9 to the Examiner today concerning the nomenclature of cer-
10 tain pools in Eddy and Chaves Counties, New Mexico?

11 A Yes, I am.

12 Q Are your recommendations prepared in the
13 form of an exhibit?

14 A They are.

15 Q And how is that exhibit denominated?

16 A Exhibit Number One.

17 Q Would you please refer to Exhibit Number
18 One and to the docket that's been distributed for the
19 hearing today and point out any differences that may exist
20 between the two, if any?

21 A There are no differences between the
22 exhibit and the docket.

23 Q Was Exhibit One in this case prepared
