Current rules for the development and production of this pool do not operate to prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells thereby causing waste nor do these rules, nor the general rules of the Oil Conservation Division, including the ratable take rules, allocate production so as to prevent drainage that cannot be offset by counter drainage, thereby protecting correlative rights.
- 6. To protect the correlative rights of all interest owners in this pool, and to provide for orderly development of this pool in a manner that will avoid the waste that results from the drilling of the unnecessary wells, rules and regulations should be promulgated for the South Shoe Bar Atoka Gas Pool which include provisions for the allocation of the allowable production among the wells in the pool on a straight acreage basis.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this case be set for hearing before the Oil Conservation Commission on January 19, 1989, and that after notice and hearing as required by law the Commission enter its order instituting gas prorationing in the South Shoe Bar - Atoka Gas Pool and promulgating special pool rules and regulations for this pool, including a provision for the allocation of the allowable production among the wells in the pool on a straight acreage basis.

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


