1 DIRECT EXAMINATION

2 BY MR. STOVALL:

3 Q Would you please state your name, by
4 whom you're employed, and in what capacity?

5 A I'm Victor T. Lyon, employed by the Oil
6 Conservation Division as Chief Engineer.

7 Q Mr. Lyon, have you previously testified
8 before the Commission or its examiners and had your cre-
9 dentials accepted?

10 A Yes, I have.

11 Q Are you prepared to make recommendations
12 to the Examiner today concerning the nomenclature of cer-
13 tain pools in Chaves and Eddy Counties, New Mexico?

14 A Yes, I am.

15 Q Are your recommendations prepared in the
16 form of an exhibit?

17 A Yes, I think the advertisement serves as
18 the exhibit, does it not?

19 Q Plus I think you have -- what you have
20 in the file is also your exhibit, I believe.

21 A Oh, all right, let me find it. Yeah,
22 okay.

23 Q How is that exhibit denominated? Have
24 you prepared that in the form of Exhibit A?

25 A Yes, I have.

1 Q Would you please refer to Exhibit A and
2 to the docket that's been distributed for the hearing to-
3 day and point out any differences between the two?

4 A Yes. We feel that it is advisable to
5 dismiss Paragraph (c) as published in the docket.

6 And that Paragraph (d) be amended by
7 deleting from the acreage descriptions under Township 16
8 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, we would delete Section 6, All.

9 And other than that we recommend that
10 these changes be adopted.

11 Q Was Exhibit A in this case prepared by
12 you or under a member of the Division staff and have you
13 had the opportunity to review it and verify its contents?
