## APPLICATION

COMES NOW the Applicant Mobil Producing Texas-New Mexico,
Inc. by and through its attorneys, Montgomery & Andrews, P.A. and
applies to the Division for an order authorizing the downhole
commingling of the Blinebry and Drinkard gas producing formations
in the Brunson-Argo well no. 6 located in Section 10, Township
25S, Range 37E, Lea County New Mexico. In support of said
Application, Applicant states:

- 1. Mobil Producing Texas-New Mexico, Inc. is the operator of the Brunson-Argo well no. 6 located 1,980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West line of Section 10, Township 22S, Range 37E, Lea County, New Mexico.
- 2. This well is currently producing gas from the Blinebry and Drinkard formations by dual completion.
- 3. That in order to increase the efficiency of operation of this well and to maximize the recovery of gas reserves from these two zones operator proposes to commingle these two zones.

WHEREFORE, Applicant Mobil Producing Texas-New Mexico, Inc. prays the Division hold a hearing on this matter and at the conclusion of that hearing, enter its order approving the downhole commingling of the Blinebry and Drinkard zones in the well bore of this well.
