A P P L I C A T I O N

COMES NOW MERIDIAN OIL INC. ("Meridian"), by and through its attorneys, Kellahin, Kellahin & Aubrey, and applies to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division to contract the vertical limits of the existing Parkway-Delaware Oil Pool by deleting the Delaware "B" Sand from said pool and redesignating the pool as the Parkway-Delaware "A" Sand Oil Pool and to create a new pool designated as the Parkway-Delaware "B" Sand Oil Pool for production from the Delaware "B" Sand. Both of said pools are to be subject to the statewide rules and regulations promulgated by the Oil Conservation Division for wells of this depth based upon 40-acre oil well spacing. In support of its Application, Meridian would show:

1. Meridian is the operator of some five wells that are currently dedicated to the Parkway-Delaware Oil Pool located in Section 35, Township 19 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, all of which are currently completed in and produce from the Delaware "A" Sand.

2. Applicant has drilled and is currently producing it's Apache "A" Federal #1 Well (the discovery well), which is located in Unit B of Section 35, Township 19 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

3. Said well is completed in the Delaware "B" Sand and constitutes a new discovery of a separate common source of supply, which should be designated the Parkway-Delaware "B" Sand Oil Pool.

4. The Delaware "B" Sand is the upper sand pool and the Delaware "A" Sand is the lower sand pool, each of which is vertically separated from the other by approximately 100 feet.

5. Reservoir and geologic data available demonstrate that each sand pool constitutes a separate and distinct source of supply from the other and each should be treated as a separate pool.

6. The vertical limits for the existing Parkway-Delaware Oil Pool should be contracted to consist of only the Delaware "A" Sand.

7. The vertical limits for the new pool should be the Delaware "B" Sand, as found on the porosity log of the discovery well from approximately 3940 feet to 4016 feet.

8. The vertical limits for the current Parkway-Delaware Oil Pool should be contracted to reflect the vertical interval in the redesignated Parkway-Delaware "A" Sand from approximately 4,110 feet to 4,220 feet as shown on the porosity log of Meridian's Apache "A" Federal #1 Well.

9. The initial horizontal limits for the new pool should be all of Section 35, Township 19 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

10. The effective date of the creation of the new pool should correspond to the date of the first production of the discovery well, which was June 16, 1989.


11. Adoption of Temporary Special Rules shall be for a period of two years and said rules will provide for the orderly development of the two pools, avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

12. A copy of this application has been sent to all interested parties as shown on Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

13. Applicant requests that this matter be set for hearing on the examiner's docket now scheduled for August 9, 1989.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, the application be granted as requested.
