



APPLICATION

COMES NOW, TXO PRODUCTION CORP, by and through its attorneys, KELLAHIN, KELLAHIN & AUBREY, and in accordance with Section 70-2-17(c) N.M.S.A. (1978) applies to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for an order pooling all mineral interest as follows: From the top of Wolfcamp Formation to base of the Pennsylvanian Formation, underlying the N/2 of Section 16, T18S, R31E, Eddy County, New Mexico, including, but not limited to the North Shugart Morrow Gas Pool, and the North Shugart Atoka Gas Pool, said unit being approximately 7.5 miles Southeast of Loco Hills, New Mexico, and in support thereof would show:

- 1. All the working interest owners in Section 16, T18S, R31E have reached a voluntary agreement for this well except as follows:
 - (1) ARCO Oil and Gas Company 40 acres P.O. Box 1610 Midland, Texas 79702 Attn: Tim Dergio NE/4NE/4

- 2. Applicant desires to be designated operator for a well to be drilled at standard location in NW/4 of Section 16.
- 3. Applicant has sought a voluntary agreement with all the working interest owners for the formation of appropriate spacing and proration unit for the drilling of the subject well, but has been unable to obtain a voluntary agreement from ARCO.
- 4. Pursuant to the Division notice requirements,
 Applicant has notified ARCO of this Application for
 compulsory pooling and the Applicant's request for a hearing
 before the Division to be set on February 7, 1990.
- 5. In order to obtain its just and equitable share of the potential production underlying the above tract, Applicant needs an order pooling the mineral interest involved in order to protect Applicant's correlative rights and prevent waste.

WHEREFORE, Applicant prays that this Application be set for hearing before the Division's duly appointed examiner, and that after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter its order approving the pooling of the mineral interest described herein. Applicant further prays that it be named operator of the well, and that the order make provisions for it to recover out of production its costs of drilling, completing and equipping the subject well, costs of operation, including costs of supervision,

and a risk factor in an amount to be determined at the hearing for the drilling and completing of the well and for such other and further relief as may be proper.




