Pursuant to Rule 1207(a) 1 and 3 of the Rules on Procedure, we have notified by certified mail, return receipt requested, those parties listed on Exhibit "B" to the Application as stated therein. We will provide the certificates or return receipts evidencing such notification, or attempted notification, at the hearing on the Application. We respectfully request you publish notice of the enclosed Application according to Rules 1204 and 1205 and place the enclosed Application on the docket for hearing before an Examiner on March 21, 1990.

Please be advised that, pursuant to the letter agreements referenced on Exhibit "B" of the enclosed Application, Doyle Hartman has reached definitive written agreements to acquire the working interest of Oxy USA, Inc. ("Oxy") within the SE/4 of Section 5 and the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 8, as well as the working interest of Oryx Energy Company ("Oryx") in the NE/4 SE/4 of Section 5, all in Township 20 South, Range 37 East, Lea County New Mexico. Oxy had previously applied to the Division in Case No. 9884 for a non-standard Eumont gas proration unit consisting of 200 acres, being the SE/4 of said Section 5 and the NE/4 NE/4 of said Section 8. Because Hartman has now acquired the working interests previously held by Oxy and Oryx in those tracts and has included such acreage within the 280-acre non-standard Eumont gas proration proposed in the enclosed Application, we expect Oxy to withdraw its Application No. 9884. In the event Oxy fails to do so, we respectfully request the Division to dismiss Application No. 9884 prior to its scheduled hearing on March 7, 1990.

Gentlemen:

Chevron U.S.A. Inc. respectfully requests your approval of our administrative application for a 160-acre Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit in the Eumont Yates-Seven Rivers-Queen (Prorated Gas) Pool comprising the W/2 NE/4, SE/4 NE/4 and SE/4 NW/4 Section 8, T-20-S, R-37-E, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. We are also requesting your approval to simultaneously dedicate this 160-acre proration unit to our Bertie Whitmire Wells No. 1 and 2, located in letter units G & B of Section 8, respectively. In support thereof, Chevron U.S.A. Inc. states the following facts:

- 1) That NMOCD Administrative Order NSP-240, issued March 3, 1956, approved a 160-acre Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit, consisting of W/2 NE/4, SE/4 NE/4 and SE/4 NW/4 Section 8, T-20-S, R-37-E, for the Bertie Whitmire Well No. 2.
- 2) That subsequent to NSP-240, an agreement was executed between Chevron U.S.A. Inc. (Gulf Oil Corporation) and Oxy U.S.A. Inc. (Cities Service) unitizing the above acreage plus the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 8.
- 3) That NMOCD Order No. R-858, effective August 16, 1956, approved a Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit of 200-acres comprising NE/4 and SE/4 NW/4 of Section 8 for the Bertie Whitmire Well No. 2.
- 4) That the above mentioned Operating Agreement and pooling order have expired due to lack of gas production in paying quantities since 1985 from the Bertie Whitmire Well No. 2.

5) That Oxy U.S.A. Inc. concurs that old gas pooling and operating agreements have terminated and Oxy does not elect to pursue new agreements for participation in Chevron's proposed re-entry of Bertie Whitmire Well No. 1.

6) That Chevron U.S.A. Inc. proposes to re-enter the Bertie Whitmire Well No. 1 and complete in the Eumont Yates-Seven Rivers-Queen (Prorated Gas) Pool and simultaneously dedicate the 160-acre Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit to both Bertie Whitmire Wells No. 1 and 2.

7) The proposed Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit complies with the following provisions:

a) The proposed unit consists of 160-acres that are contiguous.

b) The proposed unit lies wholly within a single governmental section in the Eumont Yates-Seven Rivers-Queen (Prorated Gas) Pool.

c) The entire proposed unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas from the Eumont Yates-Seven Rivers-Queen (Prorated Gas) Pool.

d) A copy of this application will be sent by certified mail to all offset operators and operators owning interests in the proposed unit's boundary and shall serve as notification.

In support of this application, attached are plats outlining the proposed Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit, the acreage to be simultaneously dedicated to our Bertie Whitmire Wells No. 1 and 2, and showing all offset operated properties and wells.

In view of the facts submitted, Chevron U.S.A. Inc. requests that administrative approval of the subject 160-acre Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit and simultaneous dedication of acreage be granted.







Gentlemen:

The gas well for the captioned Eumont Gas Unit, Chevron's Bertie Whitmire #2 well, has reached its economic limit. Under the old 1956 pooling agreement and operating agreement (see attached copies), Chevron received 1/20th of Cities share of production and paid all drilling, re-working and operating costs. Our Hobbs Division has reviewed the situation with the current well and does not believe that the No. 2 well can produce sufficient quantities of allowable gas to justify the unit well rework operation expenses at today's gas prices. Considering that the No. 2 has not produced since 1985, the Operating Agreement and pooling agreement have expired due to a lack of gas production in paying quantities. Additionally, Chevron has elected not to exercise its option to substitute the No. 1 Bertie Whitmire well for the existing No. 2 well.

Considering the above, Chevron proposes the following alternatives for OXY's approval:

Option #1

Reform a 200 acre non-standard Eumont Gas pooled unit subject to a mutually agreeable 1982 AAPL JOA for the re-entry of the #1 well located in the SW/4 NE/4 of Section 8. Estimated re-entry cost may require up to \$130,000 if two foam fracs are required to complete such well in the Eumont. Oxy would have the option to participate or Chevron would consider a farmout, subject to mutually agreeable terms.

Option #2

In the event Oxy elects not to pursue the above, Chevron and Oxy will retain 100% of their rights in their respective individual leases previously committed to the above mentioned 1956 agreements. In the event Oxy elects this alternative, Chevron will re-enter the above mentioned No. 1 well as a Chevron 100% lease well and commit its 160 acre Whitmire lease to the proration unit.

Please advise us of your intent regarding the above proposals at your earliest convenience. If you are interested in joining in the well, we will send you a detailed AFE. If we do not have your response by November 10, Chevron will assume Oxy does not desire to commit its interest in the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 8 to a joint venture. Please indicate your election below and return a copy of this letter to Chevron or fax to 713/754-2016.
