YATES PETROLEUM COMPANY, by its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application pursuant to Oil Conservation Division Rule 111 to directionally drill its Gazelle AHG Federal Com Well No. 1, and in support thereof states:

1. Applicant is the operator of the Strawn and Morrow formations underlying the S/2 of Section 15, Township 20 South, Range 29 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, and proposes to directionally drill its Gazelle AHG Federal Com Well No. 1 to test the Morrow and intermediate formations.

2. Applicant proposes to directionally drill its Gazelle AHG Federal Com Well No. 1 from a surface location of 1312 feet from the North line and 1844 feet from the West line to a bottom hole location in the Strawn formation, Burton Flat East Strawn Pool, 1980 feet from the South and East lines and a non-standard bottom hole location in the Morrow formation 1472 feet from the South line and 1540 feet from the East line of Section 15, Township 20 South, Range 29 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County.

3. Applicant proposes to dedicate to the Gazelle AHG Federal Com Well No. 1 a standard proration unit comprised of the S/2 of said Section 15.


4. The directional drilling of this well will enable the Applicant to produce the reserves which underlie the above-referenced proration unit in the most economical and efficient manner.

5. Approval of this application will enable the Applicant to produce hydrocarbons that otherwise would not be produced and will otherwise be in the best interest of conservation, the prevention of waste and the protection of correlative rights.

YATES PETROLEUM COMPANY, by its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application pursuant to Oil Conservation Division Rule 111 to directionally drill its Gazelle AHG Federal Com Well No. 1, and in support thereof states:

1. Applicant is the operator of the Strawn and Morrow formations underlying the S/2 of Section 15, Township 20 South, Range 29 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, and proposes to directionally drill its Gazelle AHG Federal Com Well No. 1 to test the Morrow and intermediate formations.

2. Applicant proposes to directionally drill its Gazelle AHG Federal Com Well No. 1 from a surface location of 2280 feet from the North line and 1180 feet from the West line to a bottom hole location within 150 feet of a point 1468 feet from the South line and 1573 feet from the East line of said Section 15. Said well will be at a bottom hole location in the Strawn formation, Burton Flat East Strawn Pool, within 150 feet of a point 1815 feet from the South line and 2145 feet from the East line and at a non-standard bottom hole location in the Morrow formation within 150 feet of a point 1566 feet from the South line and 1734 feet from the East line of Section 15, Township 20

South, Range 29 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County.

3. Applicant proposes to dedicate to the Gazelle AHG Federal Com Well No. 1 a standard proration unit comprised of the S/2 of said Section 15.



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
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
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
