Gentlemen:

This office has reviewed the unexecuted copy of the unit agreement submitted for the proposed Sunfish Unit Area, Chaves County, New Mexico. This agreement meets the general requirements of the Commissioner of Public Lands who has this date granted you preliminary approval as to form and content.

Preliminary approval shall not be construed to mean final approval of this agreement in any way and will not extend any short term leases until final approval and an effective date have been given.

When submitting your agreement for final approval, please include the following items:

- Application for final approval by the Commissioner setting forth the tracts that have been committed and those that are not committed.
- All ratifications from the Lessees of Record and Working Interest Owners. All signatures should be acknowledged by a notary and one set must contain original signatures.
- 3. Order of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division. Our approval will be contingent upon subsequent favorable approval by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division.
- 4. An original and one copy of both the Unit Agreement and the Unit Operating Agreement for our files. Again, the original set must contain original signatures.

5. Please remit a filing fee in the amount of one hundred twenty dollars (120.00). This filing fee is assessed in the amount of thirty dollars (\$30.00) for each section or partial section included inside the Unit boundaries.

In furtherance of our pre-approval meeting with representatives of the Oil and Gas Division of the State Land Office on February 19, 1990, BHP Petroleum Company Inc. hereby makes application for preliminary approval of the Sunfish State Unit, Chaves County, New Mexico. This exploratory unit consists of 2195.87 acres of state lands and 39.21 fee acres. Submitted herewith for your review are the following:

- 1. The initial form of the proposed Unit Agreement.
- 2. A copy of Exhibit "A" showing the proposed unit area and the boundaries and identity of tracts and leases within the unit.
- 3. A preliminary copy of Exhibit "B" showing leasehold ownership in the unit area.
- 4. Geological Explanation.

BHP requests that all geological and geophysical data and discussions be kept confidential. We have clearly marked all material submitted as **CONFIDENTIAL**.

BHP Petroleum Company Inc. will commence the drilling of a test well prior to June 1, 1990 and drill the said well to a depth sufficient to test the Ordovician formation or to such a depth as unitized substances shall be discovered which can be produced in paying quantities. The proposed well location is 1980 feet FSL and 1980 feet FEL of Section 32, T9S, R27E, Chaves County, New Mexico.

Consequently, BHP hereby respectfully requests your preliminary approval of the lands described in Exhibits "A" and "B" of the enclosed Unit Agreement to constitute an area logically subject to unitization.

ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on April 18, 1990, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Michael E. Stogner.

NOW, on this <u>23rd</u> day of April, 1990, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:

- (1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) The applicant, BHP Petroleum Company, Inc., seeks approval of the Sunfish State Unit Area and Agreement for all oil and gas in any and all formations underlying those lands described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.
 - (3) No interested party appeared and objected to the proposed unit area.
- (4) All plans of development and operation, and creations, expansions or contractions of participating areas, or expansions or contractions of the unit area should be submitted to the Director of the Division for approval.
- (5) Approval of the proposed unit agreement should promote the prevention of waste and protection of correlative rights within the unit area.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

- The Sunfish State Unit Agreement is hereby approved for all oil and gas (1) in any and all formations underlying those lands described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.
- The plan contained in said unit agreement for the development and operation of the unit area is hereby approved in principle as a proper conservation measure; provided however, notwithstanding any of the provisions contained in said unit agreement, this approval shall not be considered as waiving or relinquishing, in any manner, any right, duty or obligation which is now, or may hereafter be, vested in the Division to supervise and control operations for the unit and production of oil and gas therefrom.
- The unit operator shall file with the Division an executed original or executed counterpart of the unit agreement within 30 days after the effective date thereof; in the event of subsequent joinder by any other party or expansion or contraction of the unit area, the unit operator shall file with the Division, within 30 days thereafter, counterparts of the unit agreement reflecting the subscription of those interests having joined or ratified.
- All plans of development and operation, all unit participating areas and expansions or contractions of the unit area, shall be submitted to the Director of the Oil Conservation Division for approval.
- This order shall become effective upon the approval of said unit agreement by the Commissioner of Public Lands for the State of New Mexico; this order shall terminate ipso facto upon the termination of said unit agreement; and the last unit operator shall notify the Division immediately in writing of such termination.
- Jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.


