COMES NOW AMERIND OIL COMPANY LIMITED PARTNERSHIP, through its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application to the Oil Conservation Division pursuant to N.M.Stat.Ann. § 70-2-17 for an order pooling all mineral interests in the Strawn formation underlying the E/2 SW/4 of Section 35, Township 16 South, Range 37 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico and for approval of an unorthodox well location, and in support thereof would show the Division:

- 1. Applicant owns or represents approximately 87.53% of the working interest underlying the E/2 SW/4 of Section 35, Township 16 South, Range 37 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, and has the right to drill thereon.
- 2. Applicant proposes to drill a well to test the Strawn formation, Shipp Strawn Pool, at a point 1300 feet from the South line and 1750 feet from the West line of Section 35.

- 3. Applicant seeks an exception to Rule 4 of the Special Pool Rules for the Shipp Strawn Pool to permit the drilling of the well at the above-described unorthodox location to a depth sufficient to adequately test the Strawn formation.
- 4. A standard 80-acre proration unit comprising the E/2 SW/4 of Section 35 will be dedicated to the well.

avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, will prevent waste and will protect correlative rights.

7. In order to permit the Applicant to obtain its just and fair share of the oil

and gas underlying the subject lands, the mineral interests should be pooled, and Applicant

should be designated the operator of the well to be drilled.

WHEREFORE, Applicant prays that this application be set for hearing before a

duly appointed Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on May 2, 1990, and that after

notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter its order pooling the lands,

including provisions for Applicant to recover its costs of drilling, equipping and completing

the well, its costs of supervision while drilling and after completion, including overhead

charges, and imposing a risk factor for the risk assumed by the Applicant in drilling,

completing and equipping the well, and making such other and further provisions as may

be proper.




