

DOYLE HARTMAN'S STATE A PROPOSAL
SEQUENCE OF EVENTS

March 9, 1990	Mr. Hartman proposed a trade which included the State A lease.
March 23, 1990	Chevron declined Mr. Hartman's offer.
April 18, 1990	Mr. Hartman proposed an infill well on the 160 acre State A lease. There is currently a 150 MCFPD producer on this lease.
May 25, 1990	Mr. Hartman proposed the formation of a 160/120 acre proration unit in the SE/4 of Section 5, Township 21-S, Range 37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.
June 4, 1990	Mr. Hartman filed for the creation of a 320 acre proration unit in the SE/4 of Section 5 and NE/4 of Section 8. He seeks forced pooling of the working interests. His proposal incorporates portions of two existing gas proration units.
June 4, 1990	Mr. Hartman invited Chevron to participate in the 320 acre unit. Chevron's interest will be diluted to 25% WI.
