ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on August 8, 1990 and September 5, 1990, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Michael E. Stogner.

NOW, on this 29th day of October, 1990, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:

(1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) The applicant, Nearburg Producing Company, seeks an exception to Rule 4 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the North Osudo-Morrow Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-3305, as amended, authorizing an unorthodox gas well location to be drilled 990 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the East line (Unit B) of Section 6, Township 20 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

(3) All of said Section 6 is to be dedicated to said well forming a 637.18-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

(4) This case was heard at the August 8, 1990 hearing; however for purposes of notification it was continued to the September 5, 1990 hearing.

(5) Subsequent to the September 5th hearing, the applicant requested this

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matter be dismissed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

Case No. 10032 is hereby dismissed.
