

Doyle Hartman supports Texaco's application for establishment of minimum allowables in the Eumont Gas Pool, but asks that the OCD delay ruling on the Eumont application until it has heard and rules upon his application for minimum allowables in the Jalmat Gas Pool filed with the OCD on August 28, 1990. Mr. Hartman further states that minimum allowables should be established for both the Eumont and Jalmat Gas Pools because both pools are the same common source of supply and were separated merely by historical happenstance. These pools, with their combined remaining reserves, represent a very substantial and valuable economic resource to the State of New Mexico and must be continued to be developed in an orderly manner. Minimum allowables are necessary to achieve this goal.



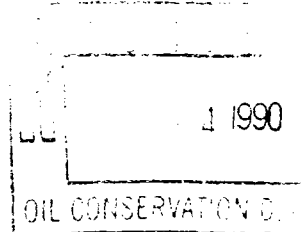


