COMES NOW MERIDIAN OIL, INC., by and through its attorneys, KELLAHIN, KELLAHIN & AUBREY, and applies to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for approval of two unorthodox gas wells in the Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool in Sections 22 and 15, Township 31 North, Range 6 West, San Juan County, New Mexico for the following wells, which have been drilled:

Rosa Unit No. 201 Well drilled at an unorthodox location 1640 feet from the North line and 420 feet from the East line of Section 22, Township 31 North, Range 6 West, N.M.P.M.

Rosa Unit No. 222 Well drilled at an unorthodox gas well location 1910 feet from the North line and 635 feet from the East line of Section 15, Township 31 North, Range 6 West, N.M.P.M., Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. 1. 
6. Attached as Exhibit C is a list of all offsetting owners and/or operators who are required by Division rules to receive notification of this application.




