APPLICATION

COMES NOW the Applicant Woodbine Petroleum, Inc. by and through its attorneys Montgomery & Andrews, P.A., and applies to Division for an exception to Division Order No. R-3221, as amended, Lea County, New Mexico. In support of said application, applicant states:

1. Applicant seeks approval for the use of an unlined salt disposal pit in the NE1/4 SE1/4 (Unit I) of Section 21, T. 19 S., R. 32 E., NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico for the disposal of water produced in conjunction with the production of oil and gas.

2. Applicant proposes to dispose of water produced from the Mobil Federal and Amoco Federal leases into this unlined pit in order to prevent waste of natural resources.


3. Applicant has provided notice of this application pursuant to the provisions of Rule 1207 of the Rules and Regulations of the Oil Conservation Division.
