OPPONENT'S STATEMENT OF OPPOSITION

Pacific Enterprises Oil Company (USA) appears in this case in opposition to the application of Matador Petroleum Corporation. Pacific is an interest owner in the S1/2 of Section 5, T. 20 S., R. 34 E., part of which acreage is included within the area of the proposed forced pooling. Pacific believes that a S1/2 dedication of acreage to a well drilled at a standard S1/2 location is more appropriate and Pacific proposes to drill a well in the S1/2. Therefore Pacific opposes the inclusion of any S1/2 acreage in the proposed pooling.


PROCEDURAL MATTERS


