**APPLICATION OF THE OIL CONSERVATION  
DIVISION FOR ORDER ANACTING AND  
ADOPTING A RECODIFICATION OF THE  
RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE OIL  
CONSERVATION DIVISION**

The Oil Conservation hereby applies to the Oil Conservation Commission for an order repealing the existing Rules and Regulations and enacting a recodification of those Rules and Regulations and in support thereof states:

1. The current Rules and Regulations are a compilation of Rules enacted over many years, and they vary widely in paragraph structure and format.
2. Under the existing format determination by users of the Rule Book of whether or not each of the rules is current is very difficult without referring to the official compilation of individual rules filed with the New Mexico State Records Center.
3. The proposed format utilizes more up to date word processing capabilities to generate rules in a consistent format.
4. Utilizing the new format, the Division will be able to incorporate revisions to the rules in a timely manner and provide users with replacement pages to enable them to keep their rulebooks up to date.
5. The new format will show an effective date for each rule, and the Division will provide users with a complete and current list of rule effective

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CASE 10143:

The Division seeks to recodify all of its Rules and Regulations to make the format and paragraphing consistent throughout and to establish a single effective date for all rules. There will be no substantive changes to any rule as a result of this recodification.

CASE 9018: (Reopened)

In the matter of Case 9018 being reopened pursuant to the provisions of Commission Order No. R-8170-C which order, among other things, promulgated Rule 11(h) of the General Rules for Prorated Gas Pools in New Mexico providing for the reinstatement of allowable to wells which suffered cancellation of allowable under certain specified conditions. The Commission shall consider whether said Rule 11(h) should be continued or rescinded.
