

Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

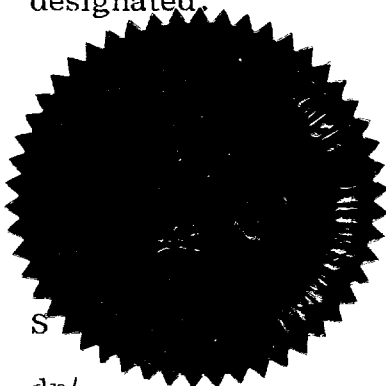
FINDS THAT:

The applicant's request for dismissal should be granted.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:
