This letter is a follow up to our letter of November 15, 1989 requesting the E/2, E/2 of Section 3, T-25-S, R-37-E be added to the existing Farmout Agreement C-4765 in Lea County, New Mexico. This additional 160 +/- acres will be subject to the following:

- That upon completion of all terms and conditions of the existing Farmout Agreement C-4765, Lea County, New Mexico, assuming Tahoe Energy has performed and satisfied all the terms and conditions of said Farmout Agreement, the (160+/-) acres in the E/2, E/2 of Section 3, T-25-S, R-37-E be added to the existing Farmout Agreement C-4765.
- 2.) That all terms in the existing Farmout Agreement C-4765 would apply the same as if the E/2, E/2 Section 3, T-25-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico had been included with the original acreage.

Assuming this request can be acted upon immediately, the E/2, E/2 of Section 3 will be included with the remaining undeveloped acreage in our current action seeking a court ordered schedule for surface damages to be paid to the surface owner, Ms. Rebecca Jo Doom.
