Enclosed for your further handling and information is a copy of Order No. R-9414 issued by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division regarding compulsory pooling for the captioned well to be drilled by Mewbourne. Also enclosed in this regard is a copy of Mewbourne's Authorization for Expenditure (AFE) for the captioned well which is an estimated well cost.

The above is furnished to you as you are the surviving executrix of the Estate of Myrtle Stubblefield, Deceased. The enclosed pooling order does not effect your individual interest under the captioned land, since we have a lease with you.

Although Mrs. Stubblefield left a Last Will and Testament dated December 11, 1967, we are treating the Will as inoperative and are treating her estate as an intestate estate. As set out in paragraph four (4) of her Will, she apparently left verbal instructions for her executrices to distribute the residue of her property to her nieces as designated by her. We can find no evidence that these instructions were in writing and that the residue of her property was properly distributed to the nieces intended.

Since there are many heirs involved in the Estate of Myrtle Stubblefield, most of whom we are in contact with, have leased their interest or are in the process of leasing their interest, there always is the possibility that there may be some unknown heirs or heirs we cannot locate or lease.

As we are contractually bound under the terms of an operating agreement with OXY USA Inc.
