COMES NOW PACIFIC ENTERPRISES OIL COMPANY

(USA), by and through its attorneys, KELLAHIN, KELLAHIN

& AUBREY, in accordance with statutes of the State of

New Mexico, and the Rules of the New Mexico Oil

Conservation Division, and applies to the New Mexico

Oil Conservation Division to establish statewide

spacing (320 acres) and corresponding statewide

locations for the McMillian-Morrow Gas Pool, including

but not limited to Sections 13 and 24, T20S, R26E and

Sections 7, 18, and 19, T20S, R27E, Eddy County,

N.M.P.M., with a provision to exempt both Sections 13

and 18 so long as the current wells in each of those

two sections continues to produce gas from the pool and



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upon abandonment said sections will automatically revert to statewide spacing. In the alternative, applicants seeks an Infill Drilling Provision which will allow a second gas well on a spacing unit in the pool. If necessary, applicant further seeks the approval of its well to be drilled 660 feet FSL and 1980 feet FWL of Section 18, T2OS, R27E, as an unorthodox gas well location in the McMillian-Morrow Gas Pool with a dedication of 320 acres being the S/2 of said section. In support of this application, applicant would show:

- 1. Applicant has the right to drill and develop the S/2 of Section 18, T2OS, R27E, Eddy County, New Mexico. Said location is within the geographical boundaries of the McMillian-Morrow Gas Pool.
- 2. In the event that the application is not granted, then applicant will propose a well at an unorthodox location, 660 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the West line of Section 18, and a non-standard proration unit of 320 acres for the S/2 of said Section 18.
- 3. The McMillian-Morrow Gas Pool was established on June 8, 1965 by Order No. R-2917 on 640-acre spacing.

- 4. By Order No. R-5829 entered October 6, 1978, the Division limited the pool rules to wells within the boundaries of this pool.
- 5. Since 1964, statewide spacing for wells of this depth has been 320 acres.
- 6. If the McMillian-Morrow Gas Pool were established today, it would be spaced on 320 acres.
- 7. Applicant will show that wells completed in the McMillian-Morrow Gas Pool will not drain in excess of 320 acres and should, therefore, be governed by the Statewide Rules rather than the current rules of 640-acre spacing for said pool.
- 8. There are only two wells currently producing in the pool each of which is dedicated to a 640-acre spacing unit. A procedure should be adopted to allow those two operators to elect to exempt those respective sections from reversion to 320-acre spacing until such time as the subject wells are plugged and abandoned in this pool.
- 9. Notice of this application to establish statewide spacing or in the alternative for an unorthodox gas well location and non-standard proration unit and of applicant's request that this matter be set

for hearing on February 21, 1991 has been given in accordance with N.M.O.C.D. Rule 1207(4) as set forth on Exhibit "A".

10. In order to obtain its just and equitable share of the hydrocarbons underlying the above tract(s), applicant needs an order pooling the mineral interests involved in the order to protect applicant's correlative rights and prevent waste.

WHEREFORE, applicant prays that this application be set for hearing before the Division's duly appointed examiner on February 21, 1991, and that after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter its order establishing statewide gas spacing in the McMillian-Morrow Gas Pool, or in the alternative for an unorthodox gas well location and non-standard proration unit and for such other and further relief as may be proper.
