

the record and being fully advised in the premises,

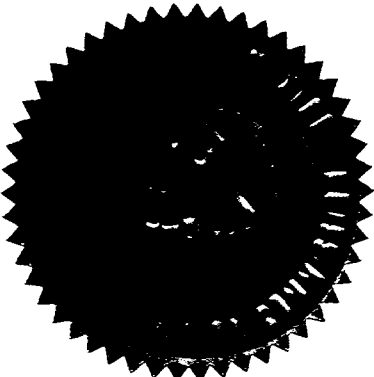
FINDS THAT:
