Energy Reserves Group, Inc., by its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application for approval of an unorthodox gas well location and a non-standard unit, and in support thereof states:

- Applicant seeks approval of an unorthodox gas well location in the N1/2 of Section 18, Township 6 South, Range 34 East, N.M.P.M., Roosevelt County, New Mexico.
- 2. Applicant has drilled and completed a gas well located 660 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West line of the Section. The N1/2 of the Section is to be dedicated to the well.
- 3. The well is governed by the South Peterson-Pennsylvanian Associated Pool rules, which require 320 acre spacing units for gas wells.
- 4. The N1/2 of the Section is irregular in size and contains 228.89 acres, more or less. Therefore Applicant seeks approval of a non-standard unit.
- 5. Approval of the unorthodox well location and non-standard unit will be in the interests of conservation, the prevention of waste, and the protection of correlative rights.

6. Applicant requests that this matter be set for the April 25, 1984 Examiner hearing.
