Coastal Oil & Gas Corporation, by its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application for approval of an unorthodox oil well location, and in support thereof states:

1. Applicant seeks approval of an unorthodox well location for an oil well to be drilled to a proposed depth of 9,900 feet from the surface in the Tulk Pennsylvanian field in the SE1/4 of Section 27, Township 14 South, Range 32 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico.

2. Applicant proposes to drill the well 1980 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the East line of the Section.

3. The SE1/4 of Section 27 is to be dedicated to the well.

4. Approval of the unorthodox location will be in the interests of conservation, the prevention of waste, and the protection of correlative rights.

5. Applicant requests the setting of this matter for the regular Examiner hearing on June 6, 1984.
