Dear Mr. Ramey:

On July 18, 1984, on behalf of Penroc Oil Corporation, I filed a DeNovo Application in the above referenced case.

Mr. Talley of Penroc Oil Corporation has advised me that he desires to obtain additional well information and data to further justify his application. I understand that the Commission is setting DeNovo Hearings in mid-September and that the first 90-day emergency period will expire before the Commission can complete processing of this case.

Pursuant to Order R-7453, paragraph (3), we request an additional 90-day Emergency Hardship Gas Well Classification for the subject well to commence at the end of the current emergency period.

We further request that the DeNovo Hearing be set in the last two weeks of the second 90-day emergency period to allow us the maximum amount of time to gather additional data thereby providing a sufficient period of time in which to adequately process this application.
